General Information:

Membership - There are three types:

- 1. **Full** For active hams that wish to vote or hold office.
- 2. **Associate** For hams that just want to help support the club and be included on the roster. Associate members cannot vote or hold office.
- 3. **Family** For an immediate family member living in the same household as a Full member. Family members cannot vote and are not on the mailing list.

One-time initiation fee - There is a fee of **\$5** for all first-time members. If you have been a member in the past, the fee does not apply.

Web Site - We have a well-featured and useful Amateur Radio web site. All members and interested non-members are encouraged to use it.
